

Council Workshop  
March 7, 2006

Councilman King called to order the public workshop of March 7, 2006 at 7:00 pm.

Members Present: Council members Jean Arrant, Earl King, Ray Jackson, Charlie Simmons were present. Mayor J.M. Marse and Council member Mike Helton were absent. Also present: City Planner Latilda Henninger, City Clerk Robin Haynes, City Attorney Clayton Adkinson, and Mr. Tonny Peters with Peters Municipal Associates.

Councilman Simmons gave the invocation and the pledge of allegiance was recited.

Ms. Henninger presented a proposed ordinance to expand the membership requirements of the City of Freeport's citizen boards to include owners of businesses within the city limits. Council members agreed with the proposed ordinance. Mr. Adkinson will revise the language on the proposed ordinance and will present it at a later council meeting.

Ms. Henninger then presented the Urban Services Area Boundary draft map. This map is to be a possible representation of where the City Council believes the future city limits may eventually end up. Ms. Henninger stressed that this will not necessarily be the city limits, just a vision of where they may possibly be. Alaqua Creek was set up as a western boundary, around Bay Loop and following Bay Grove road. There was discussion on the eastern edge boundary. It was decided to carry the eastern edge over approximately 2 miles east of the current city limits. Ms. Henninger will make the requested changes and present another draft version at the 1<sup>st</sup> public hearing to be held on March 14, 2006.

With no other business, Councilman Jackson motioned to adjourn at 7:50 pm.
