

Special Council Meeting
November 17, 2003

The Freeport City Council met for a workshop at 7 pm on November 17, 2003.

Members Present: Mayor J.M. Marse, Council members, Earl King, Jean Arrant, Mike Helton, Janice McLean, and Scott Brannon. Also present Clerk Riley.
