

City Council Workshop  
September 17, 2003

The Freeport City Council met for a workshop at 6:30pm on September 17, 2003.

Members Present: Mayor J.M. Marse, Council members, Earl King, Jean Arrant, Mike Helton, Janice McLean, and Scott Brannon. Also present Clerk Riley.

Councilman Helton gave the invocation and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Mayor Marse stated that first item on the agenda were interviews for our utility maintenance position. He explained benefits and City personnel policy. Four individuals stayed for interviews, they are as follows: Justin Hollington, Allen Thomas Henry Wright, and Randy Wright. After each separate interview, the Council chose to make a recommendation at the next Council meeting to hire Randy Wright, and Allen Thomas.

Engineer Charles Peters reviewed the water system with the Council. He explained the details of the agreement with Regional Utilities, the consumptive use permit, DEP requirements, and the need to look at upgrading areas. After a lengthy discussion on the water system Charles recommended upgrading well #4 and a storage tank. Charles plans to get definite figures on upgrading well #4.
